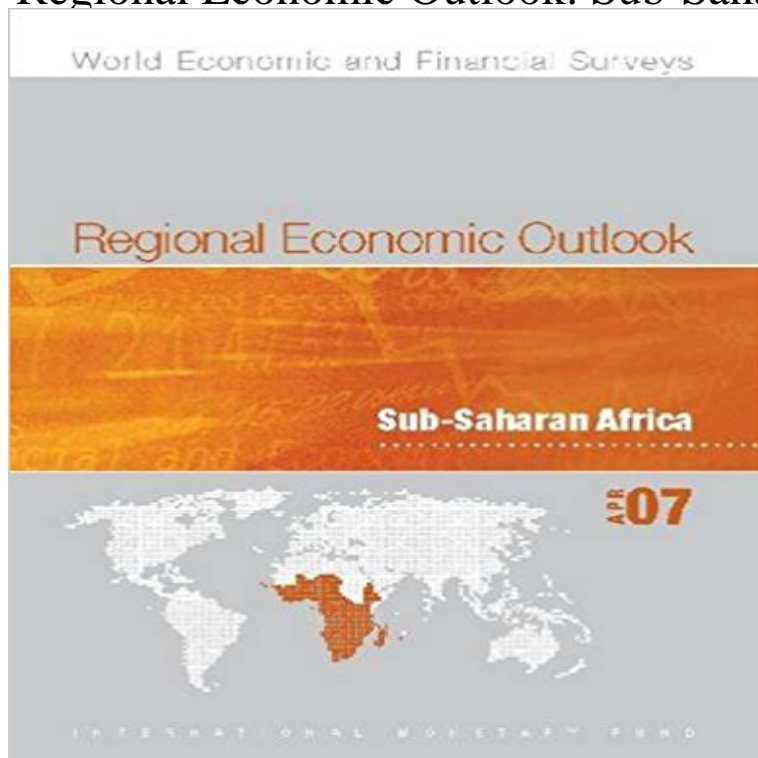


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The regions prospects look strong. Growth in sub-Saharan Africa should reach 6 percent in 2007 and 6 3/4 percent in 2008. The economic expansion is strongest in oil exporters but cuts across all country groups. This would extend a period of very good performance.
